Between: In the intermediate space, without regard to distance.

I. (Isa 59:3) But your iniquities have <u>separated</u> <u>between you and</u> <u>your God</u>, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear. (Isa 59:3); Rom 3:9-12,23; Rom 6:23; Rom 5:12

II. (I Sam 20:3)... there is but a step between me and death.

(James 4:14)Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanishes away.

(Heb 9:27) And as it is appointed unto man wants to die, but after this the judgement.

(Ps 144:4) Man is like to vanity: his days are as a shadow that passeth away.

(Ps 89:47) Remember how short my time is: wherefore has thou made all men in vain?

(Ps 89:48) What man is he that liveth, and shall not see death? shall he deliver his soul from the hand of the grave?

(Prov 16:25) There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death,

III. (I Tim 2:5) For there is one God, and one mediator <u>between</u> God and men, the man Christ Jesus.

(Mediator, n. One that interposes between parties at variance for the purpose of the reconciling them.)

By the way of eminence, Christ is the mediator, the divine intercessor through whom sinners may be reconciled to an offended God. (I Tim 2) because of this Jesus sends...

IV. (Num 16:48) And he stood <u>between</u> the dead and the living, and the plague was stayed.

A Preacher preaching life or death, Heaven or Hell, Christ or the Devil, Repent of Perish, Turn or Burn.

because there is...

V. (Luke 16:26) And beside all this, between us and you there is a

great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence.

Once your in hell there is no return!

There is a...

VI. (Gen 3:15) And i will put emnity <u>between</u> thee and the woman, and <u>between</u> thy seed and her seed; and it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

A spiritual warfare Between Jesus and the Devil.
